TARIFF AND REVISION

The tariff (VAT excluded) for the coming season is **R** *per pollination per cultivar per orchard.*

This agreement will annually be revised before

Each renewal will be binding on both parties for at least the first following season(s) from the date of signing.

1. The **SERVICE PROVIDER** undertakes to render the service defined in Table A according to the following conditions:
 - a. He will ensure that the hives comply with the standard as prescribed by WCBA and subject himself to the quality control mechanism of WCBA in this regard.
 - b. He will supply the agreed number of hives at the applicable bloom stage for the cultivar specific orchard on condition that timeous notice was given of the development of flowering.
 - c. He will attend to any real problem with immediate effect.
 - d. He will remove the hives at the applicable flowering stage on condition that timeous notice was given.
 - e. He will practise healthy business principles at all times.

2. The **PRODUCER** undertakes to accept the service defined in Table A according to the following conditions:
 - a. He confirms that the detail in Table A is correct and that it conveys his intended hive use clearly.
 - b. He will prepare and mark the hive sites and access routes properly.
 - c. He will make at least one person available to indicate the hive positions both at introduction and removal.
 - d. He will ensure the safety of the hives on his property as compensation for damages of up to twice the guideline tariff could be charged on top of the service fee.
 - e. He accepts full responsibility for his agrochemical spray programme and will ascertain that it takes into account the safety of the bees and the requirements for effective pollination.
 - f. He will release the hives as soon as the chances of adding value through further pollination because of a developed flowering stage of the cultivar specific orchard becomes ignorable. ***(95% Bloom plus 2 days will be used as guideline in this regard.)***
 - g. He will give fair notice of the time for both the introduction and removal of the hives (preferably 48 hours).
 - h. No hive will be handled without the prior permission or instructions of the Service Provider.
 - i. He will report any real problem without delay.
 - j. He will practise healthy business principles at all times.

3. WCBA do not accept any responsibility for any shortcomings in this agreement -- the parties themselves have to ascertain that this agreement is legal. This contract will also not necessarily be invalid because of for instance a few clauses being in dispute.
4. In the case of a dispute about the standard of the service, both the under- signed parties agree to making use of the WCBA Pollination Inspection Service for an investigation in this regard.
5. Any of the parties may cancel this agreement on condition that the other party had at least 24 hours written notice to rectify the possible problem.
6. No party will be held accountable by the other in the case of unforeseen circumstances ("acts of God").
